

## **NOTICE OF PUBLIC MEETING**

### **Clean Water State Revolving Fund (CWSRF) Loan Project**

The Southeast Macomb Disposal Authority (SEMSD) will hold a public meeting on the proposed Clean Water State Revolving Fund (CWSRF) Project for the purpose of receiving comments from interested persons.

Public comments regarding this proposed project will be heard Wednesday, April 26, 2023, at 4:00 pm, in the Gear Conference Room, located at 27600 Jefferson Avenue, St. Clair Shores, MI 48081.

The purpose of the proposed project is to install a new interceptor sewer from the Rio Vista Pump Station located at Rio Vista and Jefferson Avenue to the Chapaton Pump station located at 9 Mile and Jefferson. This project is intended to reduce combined sewer overflows at the Martin Retention Treatment Basin. The estimated cost to users for the proposed project is expected to be approximately \$30M utilizing a low-interest loan over a 20-year or 30-year period.

Copies of the draft plan detailing the proposed project will be available for review on the SEMSD website <https://semsd.org/>. The plan will be available on or before Tuesday, April 11, 2023.

Written comments received before the public meeting concludes on Wednesday, April 26, 2023, will receive a written response in the final project plan.
