# b. Fund Balance Policy

Mr. Walby reported the FY24 budget is currently being worked on and for informational purposes, presented some options of SMDA Fund Balance. The current balance of the SMDA is \$5.5 million for Site 9/9a and Site 11. The reserve for emergency is \$2 million. Reserved for penalties is \$1 million. The available fund balance is \$2.5 million.

Option 1 - Continue with the community funding of \$100,000.00 per year. The transfer station profit is \$350,000.00. The landfill expense if \$1 million. The beginning fund balance is \$2.5 million, and the ending fund balance is \$1,950,000.00.

Mr. Walby noted in FY28 the SMDA will be in the red and if we continue down this path.

Option 2 — Continue with the community funding of \$100,000.00 with an additional \$200,000.00 from the community. The landfill expense if \$1 million. The beginning fund balance is \$2.5 million, and the ending fund balance is \$2,950,000.00. It's not until FY31 the SMDA will be in the red. The board discussed the fund balance policy and the options.

# a. Solid Waste Disposal Agreement

Mr. Walby reported the board directed at the last meeting to put together an addendum to our SMDA Transfer Station Disposal Service Agreement with our customers. The addendum would allow our transfer station customers to dump directly to the Waste Management's Landfill at Pine Tree Acres. The solid waste agreement with Waste Management was also reviewed. Mr. Tomlinson reported the terms of the agreement was reviewed with Waste Management and he had some concerns with the language. The agreement reports that Waste Management should accept all solid waste disposal delivered by SMDA. It does not indicate to accept from SMDA customers. Mr. Tomlinson will contact Waste Management regarding the language and see if they will agree to our customers coming directly.
