b. General Updates

Mr. Trombley stated because of the dry stretch we have been working on the preventative maintenance program. One of the items is cleaning the Marter Road suction well. He explained to the

board that in July 2022 the flap gates were installed at the Marter Rd discharge pumps. Pictures were shown of the diversion sluicegate and explained when we reach capacity in the interceptor you have to go in booster mode. All the flow coming from the interceptor goes directly into the booster suction chamber. Pictures of a straightening vane which helps with vortexing of the water. He explained its good to check that they are not clogged up. Mr. Trombley stated the improvements were done in 2014 as a part of the Priority 1A Rehab. Mr. Seidel stated Lake St. Clair is down 31 inches lower compared to the record high. The new SEMSD building proposals passed by the City of St. Clair Shores Planning Department and will before the council on December 5, 2022.
